

“DR PODBIELSKI” Foundation Statutes

(consolidated text of 23 April 2020) KRS: 0000828273 NIP: 7831812833

I. General Provisions

§1

1. The Foundation named “DR PODBIELSKI” Foundation, hereinafter referred to as the Foundation, was established on the basis of a notarial deed drawn up by notary public Michał Wieczorek at the notarial office in Poznań on 10 October 2019 (Register A No. 5040/2019), subsequently amended on 13 December 2019 (Register A No. 6006/2019).
2. The Foundation operates on the basis of the provisions of the Foundations Act of 6 April 1984 (consolidated text: Journal of Laws 2018, 1491, as amended) and the provisions of these Statutes.

§2

1. The area of the Foundation's activity is the Republic of Poland.
2. In order to achieve its objectives, the Foundation may also operate outside the Republic of Poland.

II. Objectives and Tasks of the Foundation

§3

1. The statutory objectives of the Foundation are :
 1. supporting development programmes and initiatives in the fields of economics, medicine and humanities aimed at improving the living conditions of communities,
 2. supporting material and programmatic support and carrying out scientific and research work to bring about global progression in people's living conditions:
 3. providing social assistance, including assistance to families and people in difficult situations and ensuring equal opportunities for such families and people,
 4. performing activities for professional and social integration and reintegration of people at risk of social exclusion,
 5. charity,
 6. health protection and promotion,
 7. activities aimed at the disabled,
 8. activities promoting equal rights for women and men,
 9. activities aimed at people of retirement age,
 10. activities supporting economic development, including business development,
 11. activities to aid technological development, inventiveness and innovation, and to promote them and implement new technical solutions in economic practice,
 12. science, higher education, education and upbringing,
 13. culture, art, protection of cultural assets and national heritage,

14. promotion and dissemination of physical culture,
15. ecology and animal protection and natural heritage protection,
16. rescue and civil protection,
17. promotion and organisation of volunteering work,
18. activities aimed at veterans and repressed persons,
19. promotion of the Republic of Poland abroad,
20. activities for the benefit of family, maternity, parenthood, promotion and protection of children's rights,
21. preventing addictions and social pathologies,
22. activities for the benefit of non-governmental organisations and other entities carrying out public benefit activities in the scope specified in points 1-21.

III. Assets and Income of the Foundation

§4

1. The Foundation does not operate for profit and generated income will be used to achieve its statutory objectives.
2. Funds for the achievement of the Foundation's objectives and the cost of its activities shall come from:
 - a) the founding fund and donations.

§5

1. Income from grants, subsidies, donations, inheritances and bequests may be used to achieve the objectives of the Foundation only in a manner consistent with the will of the testators and donors.
2. A Donor, when transferring funds to the Foundation, may stipulate that these funds are to be used for a specific type of the Foundation's activity. If the intended use is not specified when transferring funds, the Foundation may allocate them for any statutory purpose.

IV. Bodies of the Foundation

§6

The bodies of the Foundation are:

- a) the Management Board;
- b) the Council of the Foundation.

V. Final Provisions

§7

- a) The Foundation manages its finances and accounting in accordance with applicable laws.
- b) The financial year is the calendar year.
